For decades Mrs. Bush has fought for key national and global issues including launching ground breaking education and healthcare programs in the U.S. and abroad. She founded both the Texas Book Festival and the National Book Festival in Washington D.C. As chair of the Women's Initiative at the George W. Bush Institute, Mrs. Bush continues her work on global healthcare innovations, empowering women in emerging democracies, education reform, and supporting men and women who have served in the U.S. military.

Sylvia was invited to make a trip to Uganda in 2003 where she saw so many orphaned children unable to attend any kind of schooling. She became "grandmother" to over 2,000 children and began a fund-raising effort to get these children in school. She has been very successful in her effort and today she has "her" children in day care all the way to college and has many success stories of those who graduated college already. It costs \$360 for a year of primary school, secondary school costs \$500/year and college/vocational school costs \$1,750 for a year and that is for 1 child.
